Early Intervention and Rehabilitation

\$560 million for comprehensive early intervention and rehabilitation programs across the state, to reduce youth offending and reduce the number of victims.

Mount Isa police accommodation

\$6.8 million for new residential police accommodation at Mount Isa.

New Children's Court – Mount Isa

\$4.1 million over 4 years to appoint an additional magistrate in Mount Isa.

Mount Isa Diversionary Centre upgrade

\$4 million to complete the upgrade of the Mount Isa Diversionary Centre to enable a specific service offering for women.

Victims Advocate Service

\$50 million to deliver a new professional Victims Advocate Service to provide dedicated support to victims of crime across the state, through the justice process.

Daniel's Law

\$10 million across the state to deliver a public child sex offender register to keep Queensland children safe.

Domestic and Family Violence Prevention

\$25 million across the state to deliver an electronic monitoring (GPS tracker) pilot of high risk domestic and family violence offenders.

Safer Children, Safer Communities

Stopping the youth crime pipeline across the state, being created by a broken child safety system, including a new secure care facility.

Royal Flying Doctor Service Mount Isa aeromedical base

\$6.9 million to deliver a new aeromedical base in Mount Isa for the Royal Flying Doctor Service to support its services in North West Queensland.

Dajarra staff accommodation

Staff accommodation will be delivered in Dajarra providing appropriate, safe, and fit-for-purpose accommodation, as part of the Hospital Rescue Plan.

Camooweal staff accommodation

Staff accommodation will be delivered in Camooweal providing appropriate, safe, and fit-for-purpose accommodation, as part of the Hospital Rescue Plan.

Hospital Rescue Plan

Delivering more than 2,600 extra beds across the state including 3 new hospitals and 10 hospital expansions and more regional health services.

Patient Travel Subsidy Scheme

Securing the long-term future of the Patient Travel Subsidy Scheme to deliver easier access to health services for regional and rural Queenslanders.

Surgery Waitlist Stabilisation

\$1.8 billion to deliver more elective surgeries when and where Queenslanders need them including partnering with the private sector through the Surgery Connect Program to reduce waitlists and have patients seen sooner.

Richmond Multipurpose Health Service

Progression of planning on the Richmond, Home Hill and Hughenden Multipurpose health services as part of the Hospital Rescue Plan.

Improving patient flow

\$581 million to stabilise bed capacity to improve patient flow across the state, with 515 beds across the Queensland Health system.

Midwife to patient ratios

\$48.7 million to deliver the legislated but previously under funded midwife to patient ratios across the state.

Abolishing taxes for first home buyers

First Home Owner Grant Boost extension

Hughenden Showground upgrades

\$650,000 to construct a new announcer's box and upgrade the arena surface, kitchen, bar and multifunction area to improve venue versatility. Part of the permanent Works for Queensland Program.

\$519,760 to support Burke Shire Council to design the subdivision and development of 7 industrial lots at the Burketown Industrial Estate.

Shade structure installation at Burketown Wharf Precinct

\$285,000 to install shade structures at the Burketown Wharf Recreational Precinct in Burke Shire. Part of the permanent Works for Queensland Program.

Doomadgee cycleway upgrades

\$2.2 million to deliver 2.3 km of shared walking and cycling infrastructure, improving access to essential services in the Doomadgee community. Part of the permanent Works for Queensland Program.
