#### Infrastructure to support new homes

Building the Gardner Road extension to improve north-south connectivity - delivering a four-lane carriageway, bridge, signals, active transport in Rochedale to support the development of new homes as part of the Residential Activation Fund.

## Making Queensland Safer



### **Making Queensland Safer laws**

Delivering additional justice system resourcing in Brisbane to support the implementation of Making Queensland Safer laws.

### **Wacol Youth Remand Centre Extension**

Supporting the extension of the Wacol Youth Remand Centre operations (\$51.2 million over two years).

### **Arthur Gorrie Correctional Centre**

Expanding capacity through 200 additional cells providing 400 beds at the Arthur Gorrie Correctional Centre to meet projected demand and ensure a safer environment for correctional staff, prisoners and the community.

### **Mount Gravatt Police Facility Upgrade**

Upgrading the police facility at Mount Gravatt to support frontline policing services and enhance community safety (\$30 million over four years).

### **Daniel's Law**

Implementing Daniel's Law, Queensland's first public child sex offender register.

### **Staying on Track**

Reducing repeat crime with intensive 12-month rehabilitation programs after detention to keep youth on the right path.

### **Keeping our kids safe**

Boosting the safety of children in childcare, schools and the community with \$450 million to progress recommendations from the Child Safety Commission of Inquiry, as well as establish a new Queensland Protection Commission and a first-of-its-kind Intelligence Hub.

### **More police on the frontline**

Recruiting more police to grow our frontline, including from interstate and overseas, to restore safety where you live.

### **Circuit Breaker Sentencing**

Delivering new court-ordered remote rehabilitation-focused detention for youth offenders to break the cycle of crime and make Queensland safer.

### **Proven Initiatives early intervention programs**

Delivering community-led, results-driven early intervention programs with a proven track record of success, to turn youth away from crime and make Queensland safer.

### **Domestic and Family Violence Electronic Monitoring**

Helping protect victims of domestic and family violence with an electronic monitoring pilot program for high-risk domestic and family violence offenders.





### Hospital expansion

Expanding the Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee Hospital, constructing a clinical services building with 112 new beds to deliver additional capacity, acute care and support services as part of the Hospital Rescue Plan.

### Hospital car park

Building a multi-storey car park at the Queen Elizabeth II Hospital, providing up to 1,379 spaces, as part of the Hospital Rescue Plan.

### Sunnybank Hills State School

Delivering a new building with additional classrooms and admin extension.

### Sunnybank Special School

Delivering a new two-storey general learning building and car park.

### Western Suburbs State Special School

Delivering a new administration and learning centre.

### Wishart State School

Delivering a multi-purpose court and ramp to oval.

### More social and community housing

Expanding and improving social and community housing across Brisbane's southern suburbs, with 203 homes in construction or under contract towards the delivery of 53,500 social and community homes by 2044.

### Centenary Stormers Football Club

Investing in lighting upgrades at the Centenary Stormers Football Club. Part of the *Games On!* Grassroots Infrastructure Program.

### Serbian Australian Centre Willawong

Investing in the Serbian Australian Community Centre for shade sails over the basketball courts. Part of the *Games On!* Grassroots Infrastructure Program.

### Southern Suburbs Rugby League Football Club - Junior Division

Investing in the Souths Acacia Ridge Rugby League for a lighting upgrade at the Mortimer Road facility. Part of the *Games On!* Grassroots Infrastructure Program.

### Rochedale Road and Ford Road Stormwater Infrastructure Project

Constructing stormwater infrastructure along Rochedale and Ford roads to discharge into the existing water corridor to support residential development in Rochedale. Part of the Residential Activation Fund.

### Gardner Road extension

Building the Gardner Road extension to improve north-south connectivity - delivering a four-lane carriageway, bridge, signals, active transport in Rochedale to support the development of new homes as part of the Residential Activation Fund.

### TAFE infrastructure upgrades

Delivering a new dust-extraction system for specialised student training delivery at Acacia Ridge TAFE and investing in infrastructure renewal works at Mt Gravatt TAFE and Inala TAFE.

### Moorooka bus rail interchange upgrade

Delivering upgrades to the Moorooka bus rail interchange.

### Queensland Tennis Centre upgrade

Delivering upgrades to the Queensland Tennis Centre in Tennyson to support community sports use, elite competitions like the Brisbane International and the delivery of the 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games. Part of the \$7.1 billion Games Venue Program jointly funded by the Queensland and Federal Governments.

### Digital railway transformation: Kuraby to Beenleigh

Delivering new signalling technology between Kuraby and Beenleigh to increase safety, network capacity, efficiency and reliability.

### Station Upgrades Fairfield to Salisbury

Constructing train station upgrades on the Beenleigh line from Fairfield to Salisbury.

## Better Services through a Stronger Economy



### **Protection of koala habitats in South East Queensland**

Supporting koala habitat revegetation and landscape connectivity enhancement projects through the Grassroots Environmental Grants Koala Habitat Restoration program.

### **South East Queensland Wildlife Hospital Network**

Supporting the RSPCA Wildlife Hospital at Wacol provide care to sick and injured wildlife (\$1 million in 2026-27).

### **Men's Shed improvement project**

Supporting the Mount Gravatt Men's Shed improvement project (\$2 million).

### **Frontline housing and homelessness services**

Delivering housing and homelessness services to vulnerable Queenslanders across Brisbane's southern suburbs to assist them to secure longer-term housing and access other specialist support services, including temporary accommodation, outreach and connection to broader community services.

### **Freezing South East Queensland bulk water prices**

Easing cost pressures on South East Queensland households by freezing bulk water prices for two years, saving families around \$130.

### **Skilling Queenslanders for Work**

Delivering employment and training programs in the Brisbane South to assist unemployed and underemployed Queenslanders into work as part of the annual \$80 million Skilling Queenslanders for Work investment.

### **New Medical Imaging Service for Eight Mile Plains**

Delivering a new MRI machine and CT scanner at the Eight Mile Plains Satellite Health Centre, providing easier access to vital diagnosing imaging services closer to home.

### **Expansion of Mother and Baby Units**

Delivering 30 new perinatal mental health mother and baby beds at North Queensland, Cairns, Sunshine Coast, Ipswich, Logan and Brisbane.

### **Supercharged Solar for Renters**

Driving down renters' power bills for more than 6,500 households with solar rebates, saving around \$700 a year. Eligible landlords can receive a rebate of up to \$3,500 to install solar on rental properties.

### **Boost to Buy**

Delivering the Boost to Buy home ownership scheme, supporting up to 2,000 first home buyers.

### **Zero Litter to the Bay by 2030**

Progressing partnerships with local government to upgrade stormwater network infrastructure by installing at least 100 filtration devices to prevent plastics and litter larger than 5mm escaping into Moreton Bay by 2030 (\$35 million over five years).

### **\$150 Back to School Boost**

Better relief you can rely on with a 50% increase to the Back to School Boost, with \$150 for every primary school student.

### **Healthy Kindy Kids**

Expanding the Healthy Kindy Kids program statewide, with free vision, hearing and speech development checks for children in kindergarten, giving them the best chance to be ready for school.

### **Queensland Fuel Security Plan**

Fast-tracking the Taroom Trough Development Plan and investing in new refining and storage capability on Queensland soil.
