## Making Queensland Safer



### Local courthouse infrastructure

Progressing strategic land acquisition to enable future replacement of the Beenleigh Courthouse, supporting the long-term capacity of our courts and ensuring victims receive faster access to justice.

### Delivering Anti-Hooning Camera Network

Reducing dangerous and illegal hooning activities in Rochedale South, Springwood, Daisy Hill, Shailer Park, Mount Cotton, Sheldon and Priestdale to deliver a safer and more secure community (\$2 million over three years).

### Logan Police Facility Upgrade

Upgrading the police facility at Logan to support frontline policing services and enhance community safety.

### Youth Justice Schools

Delivering a Youth Justice School in Logan for high-risk teens on Youth Justice orders to enhance educational outcomes and reduce reoffending.

### Keeping our kids safe

Boosting the safety of children in childcare, schools and the community with \$450 million to progress recommendations from the Child Safety Commission of Inquiry, as well as establish a new Queensland Protection Commission and a first-of-its-kind Intelligence Hub.

### More police on the frontline

Recruiting more police to grow our frontline to restore safety where you live.

### Circuit Breaker Sentencing

Delivering new court-ordered remote rehabilitation-focused detention for youth offenders to break the cycle of crime and make Queensland safer.

### Proven Initiatives early intervention programs

Delivering community-led, results-driven early intervention programs with a proven track record of success, to turn youth away from crime and make Queensland safer.

### Staying on Track

Reducing repeat crime with intensive 12-month rehabilitation programs after detention to keep youth on the right path.

### Domestic and Family Violence Electronic Monitoring

Helping protect victims of domestic and family violence with an electronic monitoring pilot program for high-risk domestic and family violence offenders.





### **New schools for Logan**

Delivering new schools in high-growth areas including new primary schools at Greater Flagstone and Holmview, a new secondary school at Logan Reserve, and Stage 2 works at Corymbia and South Rock state schools.

### **New special schools**

Delivering new special schools in Beenleigh, Logan Central and Logan Reserve in addition to an expansion of the existing Beenleigh Special School providing families more choice in their child's education.

### **New learning spaces for state high schools**

Delivering multi-purpose halls at Browns Plains State High School and Shailer Park State High School and a new multi-purpose hall with new learning spaces at Loganlea State High School.

### **Refurbished school amenities**

Delivering refurbished amenities at Beenleigh State School and Kingston State School.

### **Beenleigh Central Ambulance Station**

Constructing the new Beenleigh Central Ambulance Station. Part of the Queensland Ambulance Service.

### **Chambers Flat Wastewater Treatment Plant**

Constructing the Chambers Flat Wastewater Treatment Plant, pump stations and pipelines to support the development of new homes in Yarrabilba, Park Ridge and Logan Village (\$334.5 million over three years). Part of the Residential Activation Fund.

### **Cornubia Park Netball Association**

Investing in major upgrades to the netball courts and clubhouse for the Cornubia Park Netball Association. Part of the *Games On!* Grassroots Infrastructure Program.

### **Jimboomba Substation Upgrade**

Upgrading the Jimboomba Substation to support local growth and development.

### **Logan and Gold Coast Faster Rail**

Delivering the Logan and Gold Coast Faster Rail project to increase the rail network capacity and improve service reliability between Brisbane and the Gold Coast. Delivered in partnership with the Federal Government.

### **Logan Hospital Car Park**

Delivering a new multi-storey car park for patients, carers, visitors and staff at Logan Hospital, providing up to 1,008 total spaces, as part of the Hospital Rescue Plan.

### **Logan Hospital expansion (Stage 2)**

Expanding the Logan Hospital to deliver a clinical services building with 112 new beds for additional surgical capacity, acute care and support services as part of the Hospital Rescue Plan.

### **Logan Indoor Sports Centre**

Delivering a new indoor sports centre to support long-term community use and the delivery of the 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games. Part of the \$7.1 billion Games Venues Program jointly funded by the Queensland and Federal Governments.

### **Loganlea train station relocation**

Delivering the Loganlea train station and park 'n' ride relocation to accommodate future growth in the region, increasing capacity, reducing travel times and peak hour congestion. Delivered in partnership with the Federal Government.

### **More social and community housing**

Expanding and improving social and community housing, with 369 homes in Logan in construction or under contract towards the delivery of 53,500 social and community homes by 2044.

### **Infrastructure for new homes in Flagstone**

Constructing roads, water mains, booster pump station, water reservoir and sewerage infrastructure, to enable the delivery of new homes in Greater Flagstone (\$40.6 million over three years). Part of the Residential Activation Fund.

## Better Services through a Stronger Economy



### **First Home Owner Grant**

Supporting first home buyers to buy or build a new home with boosted \$30,000 grants to get into the market sooner.

### **Freezing South East Queensland bulk water prices**

Easing cost pressures on South East Queensland households by freezing bulk water prices for two years, saving families around \$130.

### **Frontline housing and homelessness services**

Delivering housing and homelessness services to vulnerable Queenslanders in Logan to assist them to secure longer-term housing and access other specialist support services including temporary accommodation, outreach and connection to broader community services.

### **Logan East Community Neighbourhood Association**

Supporting Logan East Community Neighbourhood Centre to support their community connect program (\$450,000 over three years). Part of the Community Connect initiative.

### **Expansion of Mother and Baby Beds**

Delivering 30 new perinatal mental health mother and baby beds at Townsville, Cairns, Sunshine Coast, Ipswich, Logan and Brisbane.

### **Daisy Hill Conservation Park**

Progressing the conversion of previously privately held land into the publicly accessible Daisy Hill Conservation Park, including new trail infrastructure (\$1 million in 2026-27).

### **Protection of koala habitats in South East Queensland**

Supporting koala habitat revegetation and landscape connectivity enhancement projects through the Grassroots Environmental Grants Koala Habitat Restoration program.

### **Skilling Queenslanders for Work**

Delivering employment and training programs in Logan to assist unemployed and underemployed Queenslanders into work (part of the annual \$80 million Skilling Queenslanders for Work investment).

### **Supercharged Solar for Renters**

Driving down renters' power bills for more than 6,500 households with solar rebates, saving around \$700 a year. Eligible landlords can receive a rebate of up to \$3,500 to install solar on rental properties.

### **Underwood Park car park upgrades**

Upgrading the car park at Underwood Park, Logan (\$2 million over three years).

### **\$150 Back to School Boost**

Better relief you can rely on with a 50% increase to the Back to School Boost, with \$150 for every primary school student.

### **Healthy Kindy Kids**

Expanding the Healthy Kindy Kids program statewide, with free vision, hearing and speech development checks for children in kindergarten, giving them the best chance to be ready for school.

### **Queensland Fuel Security Plan**

Fast-tracking the Taroom Trough Development Plan and investing in new refining and storage capability on Queensland soil.
