Delaneys Creek Rural Fire Brigade Station

Delivering a replacement rural fire brigade station at Delaneys Creek to support the provision of fire and emergency services to the community (\$1.4 million over two years).

PCYC Pine Rivers

Investing towards the Pine Rivers PCYC upgrade that will offer youth development programs, sport, recreation and community run-activities.

POLAIR Airborne Law Enforcement

Supporting aerial crime-fighting capability in the Sunshine Coast, Moreton Bay and Cairns regions to enhance safety in Queensland communities.

Redcliffe Police Facility Upgrade

Upgrading the police facility at Redcliffe to support frontline policing services and enhance community safety (\$44 million over four years).

Woodford Youth Detention Centre

Delivering the new youth detention centre at the Woodford Correctional Precinct, including expanding operations by an additional 32 beds, from 80 to 112 beds.

Delivering community-led, results-driven early intervention programs with a proven track record of success, to turn youth away from crime and make Queensland safer.

Staying on Track

Reducing repeat crime with intensive 12-month rehabilitation programs after detention to keep youth on the right path.

Domestic and Family Violence Electronic Monitoring

Helping protect victims of domestic and family violence with an electronic monitoring pilot program for high-risk domestic and family violence offenders.

Fixing the DNA Debacle

Continuing to deliver faster justice for victims by clearing the backlog at the DNA Lab and bolstering Director of Public Prosecutions resources to get cases to court quicker.





Elimbah intersection upgrade

Delivering improved safety at the intersection of Beerburum Road, Twin View Road and English Street, Elimbah. Part of the Targeted Road Safety Program.

Bribie Island Surf Life Saving Club

Investing in a major expansion of the Bribie Island Surf Club to provide a new function space and commercial kitchen. Part of the *Games On!* Grassroots Infrastructure Program.

Woody Point intersection upgrade

Improving safety on the intersection of Brighton-Redcliffe Road (Hornibrook Esplanade) and Oxley Avenue (Woody Point). Part of the Targeted Road Safety Program.

Bribie Island Bridge

Delivering a new Bribie Island Bridge to provide better transport for Bribie Island residents.

New Caboolture Hospital Paediatric Outpatients department

Constructing a new dedicated Paediatric Outpatients department at Caboolture Hospital.

Pine Rivers FC

Investing \$3.8 million to deliver a new clubhouse for Pine Rivers FC. Part of the *Games On!* Grassroots Infrastructure Program.

D'aguiar Highway - Caboolture to Kilcoy

Investing improved safety along the D'Aguiar Highway, including the intersections with Ironbark Drive and Lord Lane. Part of the Safer Roads, Better Transport Initiative.

More social and community housing

Expanding and improving social and community housing, with 478 homes in Moreton Bay in construction or under contract towards the delivery of 53,500 social and community homes by 2044.

Pine Rivers Netball Association

Investing in the Les Hughes Sports Complex netball building, in partnership with the City of Moreton Bay. Part of the *Games On!* Grassroots Infrastructure Program.

Moreton Bay Indoor Sports Centre

Delivering a new indoor sports centre to support long-term community use and the delivery of the 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games. Part of the \$7.1 billion Games Venues Program jointly funded by the Queensland and Federal Governments.

Moreton Bay TAFE Centre of Excellence

Constructing a new Moreton Bay TAFE Centre of Excellence, including an Advanced Manufacturing Hub, to support workforce training and address critical skill shortages (\$60 million over three years).

New Special School in Moreton Bay South

Delivering a new special school providing families more choice in their child's education.

Redcliffe Hospital Car Park

Constructing additional car parking spaces for patients, carers, visitors and staff at the Redcliffe Hospital multi-storey car park, providing more than 1,000 spaces. Part of the Hospital Rescue Plan.

Redcliffe Hospital expansion

Expanding Redcliffe Hospital with at least 210 new overnight beds as part of the Hospital Rescue Plan.

Scarborough Boat Harbour Master Plan

Investing in Phase 1 of the Scarborough Boat Harbour Master Plan Implementation.

Residential Activation Fund

Investing over \$40 million to fast-track the construction and upgrades of essential transport and utilities infrastructure to unlock land for new homes in Waraba and Woodford.

Supporting the redevelopment of the Bribie Island Neighbourhood Centre.

Dickson Community Men's Shed

Supporting the construction of new facilities for the Dickson Men's Shed and Stationery Aid at James Drysdale Reserve at Bunya (\$3.1 million over two years).

Freezing South East Queensland bulk water prices

Easing cost pressures on South East Queensland households by freezing bulk water prices for two years, saving families around \$130.

Frontline housing and homelessness services

Delivering housing and homelessness services to vulnerable Queenslanders in Moreton Bay to assist them to secure longer-term housing and access other specialist support services including temporary accommodation, outreach and connection to broader community services.

Moreton Bay Meals on Wheels

Supporting Moreton Bay Meals on Wheels with extra funding (\$300,000 over four years).

New Moreton Bay Wildlife Hospital and Education Hub at Dakabin

Delivering the Moreton Bay Wildlife Hospital and Education Hub in Dakabin (\$15 million over three years).

Protection of koala habitats in South East Queensland

Supporting koala habitat revegetation and landscape connectivity enhancement projects through the Grassroots Environmental Grants Koala Habitat Restoration program.

Skilling Queenslanders for Work

Delivering employment and training programs in the Moreton Bay region to assist unemployed and underemployed Queenslanders into work (part of the annual \$80 million Skilling Queenslanders for Work investment).

Supercharged Solar for Renters

Driving down renters' power bills for more than 6,500 households with solar rebates, saving around \$700 a year. Eligible landlords can receive a rebate of up to \$3,500 to install solar on rental properties.

Woodford State School

Delivering infrastructure to bring Years 11 and 12 to Woodford State School.

Zero Litter to the Bay by 2030

Progressing partnerships with local government to upgrade stormwater network infrastructure by installing at least 100 filtration devices to prevent plastics and litter larger than 5mm escaping into Moreton Bay by 2030 (\$35 million over five years).

\$150 Back to School Boost

Better relief you can rely on with a 50% increase to the Back to School Boost, with \$150 for every primary school student.

Healthy Kindy Kids

Expanding the Healthy Kindy Kids program statewide, with free vision, hearing and speech development checks for children in kindergarten, giving them the best chance to be ready for school.

Queensland Fuel Security Plan

Fast-tracking the Taroom Trough Development Plan and investing in new refining and storage capability on Queensland soil.
