Upgrading infrastructure and security at the Palen Creek Correctional Centre.

Continuing to deliver faster justice for victims by clearing the backlog at the DNA Lab and bolstering Director of Public Prosecutions resources to get cases to court quicker.

Victims Advocate Service

Delivering a nation leading Victims Advocate Service as a one-stop shop that provides dedicated, end-to-end support to victims of crime throughout the justice process.



Boonah Hospital

Progressing a business case for upgrading the Boonah Hospital as part of the Hospital Rescue Plan and the Building Rural and Remote Health Program.

More social and community housing

Expanding and improving social and community housing across the Scenic Rim, with seven homes in construction or under contract, as the government progresses towards its target of 53,500 social and community homes by 2044.

New indoor multi-sports facility in Beaudesert

Constructing a new indoor multi-sports facility in Beaudesert with two courts, viewing deck, amenities and parking facilities to improve accessibility, safety and user experience (\$4.8 million over three years).

Kalbar Showgrounds

Investing in lighting at Kalbar Showgrounds to improve visibility and extend event hours.

Trunk Infrastructure in Beaudesert

Constructing water, sewerage and road infrastructure to support the Golf Links Park Estate at Beaudesert (\$7.3 million over two years). Part of the Residential Activation Fund.

Beaudesert-Boonah Road

Delivering to improve safety on Beaudesert-Boonah Road, Coulson. Part of the Safer Roads Sooner Program.

Beaudesert-Nerang Road

Investing in safety improvements on Beaudesert-Nerang Road, Witheren. Part of the Safer Roads Sooner Program.

Mount Lindesay Highway, Jimboomba to Beaudesert

Upgrading the Mount Lindesay Highway (Brisbane-Beaudesert), Jimboomba to Beaudesert. Part of the Safer Roads, Better Transport Initiative.

Mundoolun Connection Road and Biddaddaba Road

Investing in improving the intersection at Mundoolun Connection and Biddaddaba roads, Boyland. Part of the Safer Roads Sooner Program.

Tamborine Mountain Road

Delivering safety improvements including signage, shoulder widening and vegetation clearing on Tamborine Mountain Road. Part of the Safer Roads Sooner Program.

Beaudesert PCYC

Investing in delivery of a new PCYC in Beaudesert, in partnership with Scenic Rim Regional Council.



Better Services through a Stronger Economy



Small Business First - Regional Business Gateways

Supporting regional small businesses to design and deliver initiatives that unlock regional opportunities and build long-term economic capacity (\$16 million over four years).

Protection of koala habitats in South East Queensland

Supporting koala habitat revegetation and landscape connectivity enhancement projects through the Grassroots Environmental Grants Koala Habitat Restoration program.

Freezing South East Queensland bulk water prices

Easing cost pressures on South East Queensland households by freezing bulk water prices for two years, saving families around \$130.

Mount Tamborine Gallery Walk improvements

Installing a new off-road car park, upgrade public toilet and build new pedestrian crossing and footpaths to improve accessibility and safety (\$2.1 million over three years). Part of the South East Queensland Community Stimulus Program.

Tamborine Mountain Sports Association

Investing in the Tamborine Mountain Sports Association to help access other funding streams on one or more discrete projects, which advance the Master Plan. Part of the *Games On!* Grassroots Infrastructure Program.

Accessible change facilities at two sports fields

Constructing inclusive change facilities at Coronation (Boonah) and Selwyn (Beaudesert) parks, featuring showers, toilets and benches (\$2.8 million over four years). Part of the South East Queensland City Deal, delivered in partnership with the Federal Government and the Scenic Rim Regional Council.

Office of the Cross-Border Commissioner

Delivering improved outcomes in border communities by maintaining the operation of the Office of the Cross-Border Commissioner. The Office is also providing funding to deliver improved outcomes in border communities through a Cross-Border Community Liaison Project.

Skilling Queenslanders for Work

Delivering employment and training programs in the Scenic Rim to assist unemployed and underemployed Queenslanders gain the skills, qualifications and experience to find and keep a job (part of the annual \$80 million Skilling Queenslanders for Work investment).

Return to work support for women in Queensland

Supporting women to access a suite of resources, workshops and development opportunities to support their return to work through the Future Women Jobs Academy program.

New CT scanner for Beaudesert Hospital

Delivering a new CT scanner to the Beaudesert Hospital, providing easier access to vital diagnostic imaging services closer to home.

Growing our Ag Industry

Supercharging Queensland's Primary Industries with on-farm innovation and investing in projects to boost Queensland primary production output to \$30 billion by 2030.

\$150 Back to School Boost

Healthy Kindy Kids

Expanding the Healthy Kindy Kids program statewide, with free vision, hearing and speech development checks for children in kindergarten, giving them the best chance to be ready for school.
